**AN ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE TECHNICAL SUPPORT AND FINANCIAL  
SUPPORT TO COMPONENT BARANGAY ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCILS  
(BADAC)**

**WHEREAS**, Article VII, Section 51 of Republic Act No. 9165, otherwise known as Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, mandates local government units to appropriate substantial portion of their respective annual budgets to assist in or enhance the enforcement of this Act giving priority to preventive or educational programs and the rehabilitation or treatment of drug dependents;

**WHEREAS**, Section V, A.1 of Department of Interior and Local Government and Dangerous Drugs Board (DILG-DDB) Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2018-01 provides that local government units shall activate, strengthen, and ensure the functionality of the local ADAC;

**WHEREAS**, Section V, A. 3 supra states that LGUs shall appropriate a substantial amount of funds for anti-illegal drug related programs, activities, and operations;

**WHEREAS**, Section V, A.4 supra states that cities may provide funds to BADACs falling under their respective jurisdictions to ensure functionality of BADACs and implementation of anti-illegal drug-related programs, activities, and operations in the barangay level;

**NOW, therefore, I, ALEX L. ADVINCULA**, City Mayor of the City of Imus, Cavite, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order to provide for the technical support and financial support to component Barangay Anti-Drug Abuse Councils (BADAC);

**THAT**, financial support and technical support to BADAC shall be defined in consonance with DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2019-117 on the 2018 Anti-Drug Abuse Council Performance Audit and Awards as:

Financial support - any type of monetary aid provided to make the anti-illegal drug program possible such as, but not limited to: financial grants, cost-sharing agreements, subsidies, and sponsorship training and/or equipment; and

Technical Support - any type of assistance provided in the implementation of anti-illegal drug activities such as, but not limited to: capacity development training, policy formulation write shops, and program formulation and planning workshops;

**THAT,** all prior issuances on the organization and functions of the City Peace and Order Council inconsistent herewith shall be deemed superseded by this Order;

**THAT,** this Executive Order shall take effect immediately.

**SO ORDERED.**
