# AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE EL NIÑO TASK FORCE IN THE CITY OF IMUS

WHEREAS, DOST PAG-ASA, on March 24, 2023 has raised the El Niño Southern Oscillation (ENSO) Alert and Warning System to El Niño Watch, based on the recent conditions and forecast models indicating that the El Niño season will likely develop in July-August-September (JAS) of 2023 and may persist until 2024;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2023-065 enjoined all Local Chief Executives (LCEs) to take precautionary measures within their respective areas of responsibility for the mitigation and preparedness for the El Niño Phenomenon 2023;

**WHEREAS**, the El Niño phenomenon may significantly negatively influence people's lives, the environment, health and socioeconomic situations in terms of fatalities, disruptions to livelihoods, opportunities, and key services, as well as damage to property and national infrastructure;

**WHEREAS**, a concerted effort is required to prepare for the El Niño phenomenon in order to lessen its negative effects on the populace of the City of Imus;

**WHEREAS**, some of the members of the Task Force are no longer connected with the City Government or re-assigned from their work station. Further, it is necessary to include additional members. Thus, the need to reorganize the El Niño Task Force.

**NOW, therefore, I, HON. ALEX L. ADVINCULA**, City Mayor of the City of Imus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order for the reorganization of the El Niño Task Force of the City of Imus.



Section 2. Functions and Responsibilities- The El Niño Task Force shall perform and carry out the following functions and responsibilities:

- Formulate a comprehensive disaster preparedness and rehabilitation plan for the El Niño phenomenon, to help the public cope with the phenomena and to minimize its disastrous effects;
- Regularly monitor the implementation of the plan;
- Conduct a massive information campaign to educate the public on the El Niño phenomenon and the needed interventions to reduce its expected adverse impact in the municipality;
- Enlist the assistance and support of any government agency on instrumentality as well as civil society in pursuance of its functions and objectives;
- e. Undertake such other functions as may be necessary to fulfill its objectives.

Section 3. Repealing Clause- All prior issuances on the organization and functions of the Council inconsistent herewith shall be deemed superseded by this Order.

Section 4. Effectivity- This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
