**AN ORDER CREATING THE COMMITTEE ON AUCTION
OF THE CITY OF IMUS**

WHEREAS, there is an imperative necessity to augment, intensify and maximize the present revenue collection of the City of Imus, Province of Cavite, in order to enhance the delivery of basic services and facilities to its constituents and residents;

WHEREAS, it has been noted that many real property owners in the City are delinquent in the payment of realty taxes (land, improvement & machinery), and notwithstanding, repeated demands (Notice of Delinquency), have continuously failed to pay and/or settle their realty taxes due to the City;

WHEREAS, as a remedial measure to protect the interest of the City, a Public Auction of delinquent real properties must be conducted to enforce the collection of realty taxes due and payable to the City;

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the City Treasurer (Local Treasurer) and consistent with the objective of the City Government to enhance the collection of real property taxes, there is a need to reconstitute the Committee on Auction;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Hon. ALEX L. ADVINCULA, City Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION- The Committee on Auction is hereby reconstituted. It shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS- The main function of the Committee herein created shall be to conduct public auction of delinquent real properties whose owners despite repeated demands, failed to pay their obligation and settle the corresponding realty taxes due to the City pursuant to RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, in relation to City Ordinance No. 04-133 series of 2019, otherwise known as An Act Providing For The Revision of the Revenue Code of the City of Imus, Province of Cavite.


The Committee shall immediately meet to devise ways and means to ensure the smooth conduct of the public auction by providing maximum protection to delinquent taxpayers, bidders, and the paramount interest of the City. The Chairperson/Chairman is hereby authorized to enlist the assistance of other City Officials and employees, especially those who have knowledge and expertise in conducting public auction.

SECTION 3. TERM OF OFFICE- The Committee is hereby directed to immediately convene and comply with Commission on Audit (COA) Memorandum Circular No. 92-386 dated October 20, 1992.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE- All orders, rules, regulations and issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Order, are hereby repealed, revoked, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY- This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
