AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE LOCAL HOUSING BOARD FOR THE CITY OF IMUS

WHEREAS, Article XII, Section 9 of the Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines provides that, "*The State shall, by law, and for common good, undertake, in cooperation with the private sector, continuing program. . . land reform and decent housing model, make available at affordable cost decent housing and basic services for the underprivileged and homeless citizens in ... resettlement areas*".

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 likewise mandates local government unit with the responsibility to provide basic services and facilities to include program and projects for low cost housing and mass dwellings.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. of 7279 (Urban Development and Housing Act), also provides for the preparation of a comprehensive and continuing housing program, establish the mechanism, for each implementation and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the growing population of Imus is expected to generate pressure on land resources. Which necessitates a rationalized and planned approach in the construction of dwelling units.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Imus recognizes the need for a long term housing plan as an integral part of the socio-economic development of the City.

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstitute the existing members of the Local Housing Board due to personnel movement brought about by the recent elections.

NOW THEREFORE, I, HON. ALEX L. ADVINCULA, City Mayor of Imus, by virtue of the powers vested upon me, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. Composition & Secretariat

- I. The Imus City Local Housing Board shall be composed of the following;

Section 2. Functions of the Board

1. Formulate the short, medium and long term shelter development plan of the City in accordance and based on the development priorities of the Imus Comprehensive Development Plan.
2. Establish policies and implementing guidelines for the City's housing program in consonance with Republic Act No. 7279.
3. Formulate police guidelines on the overall rural development program (i.e., basic services and facilities, social enterprises, security of land tenure, infrastructure, health, water and sanitation, solid waste disposal, disaster risk management directed to mitigation and adaptation vis-à-vis climate change, education, and others.
4. Monitor the implementation of the housing policies and programs of the city.
5. Obtain, establish and manage resources for the city's housing program.
6. Link and network with government agencies, bilateral organizations, non-government organizations/civil societies, and the private sectors involved in socialized housing.
7. Programs and integrated social housing delivery under the framework of convergence of resources.



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Section 3. Allocation- The city shall also appropriate funds necessary to cover the operations of the Imus Local Housing Board.

Section 4. Separability Clause- If for any reason, any part or provisions of this Executive Order shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions which are not affected shall continue to be in full.

Section 5. Repealing Clause- All rules and regulations and other issuances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Executive Order, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 6. Effectivity- This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
