AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE CITY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD (CSWMB) OF THE CITY OF IMUS

WHEREAS, the Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, especially Section 11, especially Section 11 thereof provided for the creation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Board.

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 3004-1251 dated November 8, 2004, requires the resolution of Local Solid Waste Management Board.

NOW, therefore, I, ALEX L. ADVINCULA, Mayor of City of Imus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reconstitution of the City Solid Waste Management Board (CSWMB), to wit;

Section 1. Title— This Order shall be known as “An Order Reconstituting the City Solid Waste Management Board”

Section 2. Composition – The City Solid Waste Management Board is hereby reconstituted to be composed of the following:

Section 2. Functions and Responsibilities – The CSWMB shall have the following functions and responsibilities:

- a. Develop a City solid Waste Management Plan which will be submitted to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for an adoption;



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- b. Provided the necessary Logistical and operational support for an effective implementation of the approved City solid Waste Management Plan;
- c. Recommend measures and safeguard against pollution and for preservation of the natural ecosystem;
- d. Recommend measures to generate resources, funding and implementing of projects and activities as specified in the duly approved Solid Waste Management Plans;
- e. Identify areas within the city which have common solid waste management problems as basis for planning local solid waste management services;
- f. Coordinate efforts of the respective Barangays in the implementation of City Solid Waste Management Plan;
- g. Development and appropriate incentive scheme as an integral component of the City Solid Waste Management Plan;
- h. Convene meetings of the City Ecological Solid Waste Management Board at least quarterly for the purpose of integrating, synchronizing, monitoring, and evaluating the development and implementation of the City Solid Waste Management Plan;
- i. Represent the city and component Barangays in coordinating the resources operational requirements with agencies of the provincial and national government;
- j. Oversee the implementation of the City Solid Waste Management Plan;
- k. Conduct yearly review or as needs arises, the City Solid Waste Management Plan for the purpose of ensuring its sustainability, viability, effectiveness and relevance in relation to local and international developments in the field of solid waste management;
- l. Allow clustering of Barangays to solve common Solid Waste Management problems; and



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m. Call on any concerned agency or sector as it may deem necessary, for support and other appropriation action.

Section 3. Meetings – The board shall meet at least once every quarter or as may be deemed necessary.

Section 4. Secretariat– The CENRO and the Office of the City Mayor shall be the Secretariat and shall provide administrative and technical support to the CSWMB.

Section 5. Separability Clause- If any provision of this Order shall be held invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions thereof not affected thereby shall remain in full force and affect.

Section 6. Effectivity- This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon the approval hereof and shall remain in full force and effect unless sooner revoked or amended by the Local Chief Executive.
