AN EXECUTIVE ORDER REESTABLISHING THE CITY OF IMUS GENERAL ALERT- EARLY WARNING SYSTEM OR EWS FOR TYPHOON, HEAVY RAINFALL, AND EARTHQUAKE

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the State to uphold the people's constitutional rights to life, health, safety and property and to promote the general welfare of its people at all times, especially during disasters and calamities;

WHEREAS, it is likewise the declared policy of the State to institutionalize the policies, structures, coordination mechanism and programs on disaster risk reduction from national down to local levels; recognize the local risk patterns across the country and strengthen the capacity of Local Government Units (LGUs) for disaster risk reduction and management through decentralized powers, responsibilities, and resources at the regional and local levels.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) is the agency of the government mandated to observe and report the weather of the Philippines and specified adjacent areas, and to issue forecasts and warnings of weather and flood condition affecting national safety, welfare and economy.

WHEREAS, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) is a government entity mandated to establish a national early warning and emergency alert system to provide accurate and timely advice to national or local emergency response organizations and to the general public through diverse mass media; and recommend to the President the declaration of a state of calamity in areas extensively damaged.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121 or otherwise known as "*The Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management System*" mandates the establishment of a Community-Based Early Warning System to provide accurate and timely advice to national or local emergency response organizations and to the general public through diverse mass media to include digital and analog broadcast, cable, satellite television and radio, wireless communications, and landline communications.



NOW, THEREFORE, I, **ALEX L. ADVINCULA**, Chairperson CDRRMC, City Mayor, City of Imus, Province of Cavite, by virtue of the powers vested in me do hereby order:

Section 1. Reestablishment. The City of Imus General Alert-Early Warning System or EWS for Typhoon, Heavy Rainfall, and Earthquake preparedness is hereby reestablished.

Section 2. Indicators. - The following indicators shall be used to facilitate the dissemination of the City of Imus General Alert- Early Warning System or EWS:

Section 3. Information Dissemination- In order to provide accurate and timely advice to the general public during typhoon, heavy rainfall and earthquake, the Early Warning System shall be disseminated through diverse mass media, including but not limited to digital and analog broadcast, social media platforms, cable, satellite television and radio, wireless communications, and landline communications.

Section 4. Repealing Clause- Previous issuances or any portion thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby amended, modified, superseded or repealed accordingly.

Section 5. Separability Clause- If any section or provision of this Executive Order is declared void, ineffective or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the holding of such section or provision to be void or invalid for any cause whatsoever shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining sections and provisions, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effectivity Clause – This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon the date hereof and shall remain in effect until rescinded, repealed or amended.
