EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 58

**AN ORDER PRESCRIBING THE GUIDELINES FOR ACTIVITIES IN
CEMETERIES, MEMORIAL PARKS, AND COLUMBARIA IN THE CITY OF
IMUS FROM OCTOBER 31, 2022 TO NOVEMBER 2, 2022**

WHEREAS, the City Government is responsible in promoting the general welfare of its constituents.

WHEREAS, in keeping with the Filipino tradition to visit the graves of their dearly departed loved ones during the Undas season, and taking into consideration the COVID-19 pandemic, it is necessary to issue guidelines for Undas 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **ALEX L. ADVINCULA**, City Mayor of Imus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order as follows:

1. All cemeteries, memorial parks, and columbaria in the City of Imus shall be given permission to open as follows:

October 31, 2022 -	5 am to 6pm
November 1, 2022 -	5 am to 6 pm
November 2, 2022 -	5 am to 6pm

2. Visitors to the cemeteries, memorial parks, and columbaria must be fully-vaccinated against Covid-19. They must also present their vaccination cards at the gates of the cemeteries.
3. Individuals with body temperatures of 37.5 °C or higher shall not be allowed to enter the cemeteries, memorial parks, and columbaria. Those with high temperature shall be given a 10-minute rest and will be checked again.
4. "One Entrance, One Exit" policy shall be adopted.
5. Visitors shall be encouraged to observe the minimum health protocols — physical distancing and the wearing of face mask.

6. Bringing alcoholic beverages, deck cards, bingo cards or gambling materials, flammable materials, firearms, and sharp objects like knives or cutters, and sound systems are strictly prohibited.
7. All visitors shall observe proper waste disposal and apply "Clean as You Go".
8. Staying overnight is strictly prohibited.
9. Burial, internment, or cremation shall be suspended from October 31 to November 2, 2022, except for cases of immediate burials.
10. The Imus City Police Office shall set up Police Assistance Desks in or near cemeteries, memorial parks, and columbaria for security and law enforcement purposes and to assist in crowd control.
11. Designated parking area and common vending area for ambulant vendors shall be identified so as not to disrupt the flow of traffic in the area.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon the date hereof.
