EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 60

AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE CITY OF IMUS PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD (PLEB)

WHEREAS, by virtue of Republic Act Nos. 6975 and 8551, mandates the establishment of the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) in every local government which serves as the central receiving entity for any citizen's complaint against any officers and members of the City of Imus Police Office;

WHEREAS DILG MC No. 98-116 provides for the reconstitution of local special bodies including the PLEBs, in accordance with the Article 64 (e) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS the recent change in the bureaucracy had led to personnel movement and brought the need to reconstitute the People's law enforcement board.

NOW, therefore, I, ALEX L. ADVINCULA, Mayor of the City of Imus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

Section 1. Title – This Order shall be known as "An Order Reconstituting the City of Imus People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB)",

Section 2. Composition— The City of Imus People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) is hereby reconstituted to be composed of the following:

Section 3. Term of Office – The members of the PLEB shall be for a period of three (3) years from assumption of office. Such member shall hold office until his/her successor shall have been chosen and qualified.

The tenure of office of a PLEB member who has been designated as such by virtue of his election to the Sangguniang Panlungsod or his membership with the Liga ng mga Barangay ends upon the expiration of his term of office as Sangguniang Member or as Punong Barangay.

Section 4. Funding and Compensation— Membership in the PLEB is a civic duty, however, PLEB members including its designated support staff shall be paid per diem. A maintenance and operation of the PLEB shall be included in the annual budget of the city.

Section 5. Separability Clause- If any provision of this Order shall be held invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions thereof not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effectivity— This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon the approval hereof and shall remain in full force and effect unless sooner revoked or amended by the Local Chief Executive.
