AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD (LSB)

WHEREAS, Section 98, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that there shall be established in every province, city or municipality a provincial, city or municipal school board;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, Local Government Code of 1991 provides for the composition of the Local School Board (LSB);

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstitute the current Local School Board (LSB) due to personnel movement brought about by the recent change in bureaucracy after the 2022 national election.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HON. ALEX L. ADVINCULA, Mayor of the City of Imus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reconstitution of the of the Local School Board, as follows:

Section 1. Composition- The membership of the Local School Board (LSB) shall be composed of the following:

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In the exigency of public service and in case of absence of the Chairperson, the City Administrator shall assume the former's duties and functions in the LSB. All the above-named offices and/or persons named as members in herein section are also hereby directed to further name their alternate permanent representatives to the LSB who shall also take their place in case of their absence.

The Chairperson or her authorized representative shall identify appropriate personnel to comprise the technical staff of the LSB.

Section 2. Functions- The LSB shall exercise the following functions as mandated in Section 99 of Republic Act No. 7160:

- A. Determine, in accordance with criteria set by the Department of Education, the annual supplemental budgetary needs for the operation and maintenance of public schools within the city, and the supplementary local cost of meeting such needs, which shall be reflected in the form of an annual budget corresponding to its share of the proceeds of the special levy on real property constituting the Special Education Fund and such other sources of revenues as laws and ordinances may provide;*
- B. Authorize the City Treasurer to disburse funds from the Special Education Fund pursuant to the budget prepared and in accordance with existing rules and regulations;*
- C. Serves as advisory committee to the Sangguniang Panlungsod concerned on educational matters such as but not limited to, the necessity for and the uses of local appropriations for education purposes; and*
- D. Recommend changes in the names of public schools within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Imus for enactment by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.*

The Department of Education shall consult the LSB on the appointments of division superintendents, district supervisor, school principals and other school officials.

Section 3. Operational Expenses and Funding- All members and personnel who are performing functions of the LSB are hereby authorized to claim for incidental



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expenses relative to the services rendered in addition to their duties and responsibilities and for work beyond office hours subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations chargeable against budgetary allocations of the LSB.

Section 4. Repealing Clause- All Executive Orders or issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

Section 5. Separability Clause- In case any of the provisions herein stated is declared by competent court to be unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section 6. Effectivity Clause- This order shall take effect immediately.
