AN EXECUTIVE ORDER FOR THE REORGANIZATION OF TASK FORCE TOMAHAWK

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code mandates that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, there is an alarming rate of Road Crash Incidents (RCI) in the City of Imus due to undisciplined and irresponsible motorists;

WHEREAS, it was found out that majority of Road Crash Incidents (RCI) happen in the wee hours of 12:00 MN to 5:00 AM;

WHEREAS, in the interest of public peace and order, there is a necessity for the City Government of Imus to create a task force with a view of reasonably and effectively alleviating the Road Crash Incidents (RCI) in the City of Imus especially during midnight hours;

NOW, therefore, I, HON. ALEX L. ADVINCULA, City Mayor of the City of Imus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the creation of Task Force Tomahawk;

SECTION 2. Duties and Responsibilities- The task force shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. The City of Imus Traffic Management Unit (CITMU) shall serve as the lead unit of the task force. It is mandated to enforce current traffic laws and apprehend traffic violators;
- b. The Philippine National Police (PNP) Imus shall be responsible for the security and orderliness of the public. They shall ensure police visibility especially through 12:00 MN to 5:00 AM along the major and minor thoroughfares of the City of Imus; and
- c. The Civil Security Unit (CSU) shall be responsible for security assistance to maintain peace and order at the place of incident. The unit shall also do security inspections throughout the City to avoid or preempt any incident that may arise.

Section 3. Effectivity- This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full effect unless otherwise revoked.
