**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER DECLARING SUSPENSION OF WORK IN ALL
GOVERNMENT OFFICES AND AGENCIES IN THE CITY OF IMUS ON 02
SEPTEMBER 2024 DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER**

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the State to uphold the people's constitutional rights to life, health, safety, and property and to promote the general welfare of its people at all times, especially during disasters and calamities;

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) of Imus City and in consideration of the inclement weather in the City of Imus, it is imperative to implement a localized suspension of work on all government offices and agencies;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, or the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall, among others, ensure and promote health and safety and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) (2) (iii) of the Code provides that the City Mayor shall issue such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HON. ALEX L. ADVINCULA, City Mayor of the City of Imus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the **SUSPENSION OF WORK IN ALL GOVERNMENT OFFICES AND AGENCIES EXCEPT THOSE OFFICES INVOLVED IN PROVIDING ESSENTIAL PUBLIC SERVICES AND ARE DIRECTLY INVOLVED IN DISASTAER/EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS** in the City of Imus on 02 September 2024.




