**AN ORDER DESIGNATING MR. ALVIN A. ANGKICO AS POLLUTION CONTROL OFFICER OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF IMUS**

**WHEREAS**, it is provided for in the 1987 Constitution that the State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Code of 1991 states that Local Government Units shall share with the national government the responsibility in the management and maintenance of ecological balance within their territorial jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, the broad spectrum of environment is a vital concern for the City Government of Imus;

**WHEREAS**, to adhere to the principles of a balanced and healthful ecology, the City of Imus establishes and enacts a comprehensive program of environmental protection and management;

**NOW**, therefore, I, **ALEX L. ADVINCULA**, Mayor of the City of Imus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the designation of **MR. ALVIN A. ANGKICO** as **Pollution Control Officer** of the City Government of Imus.

**Section 1. FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF POLLUTION CONTROL OFFICER.**

1. Monitor the discharge of waste materials from the sewerage treatment plant (STP), smoke emission from the generator set and toxic, infectious, hazardous wastes and residual wastes of the city's rural health centers';
2. Submit regular reports to DENR- EMB;
3. Represent the city in all meetings concerning pollution management matters.



**Section 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** Should any provision of this Executive Order be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other section or provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 4. EFFECTIVITY.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full effect unless otherwise revoked.
